REQUEST FOR DRIVER SAFETY COURSE

“I HEREBY ENTER MY APPEARANCE AND MY PLEA OF Guilty/ Nolo Contendere in the above and numbered cause.”

I understand that:

- If I complete a DRIVER SAFETY COURSE approved by the Court and the T.E.A. within 90 days from the date of request shown below , and
- Provide the necessary proof of that fact , and
- Submit to the Court proof that I have complied with the State of Texas’ requirement to provide financial responsibility for operating a vehicle within the State of Texas,

This case will be dismissed. However, should I fail in any requirement I understand that I am ordered to appear in person or by counsel before the said Court at 10:00AM :

I have sent or owe the Court State levied fees in the amount of \$110.00 as required.

I am verifying to the Court that at the time of the offense :

- I had been issued a valid Texas operator’s license or permit, and
- I have not successfully completed a driver safety course within the last twelve (12) months , and
- I have not successfully completed a driver safety course that is not reflected on my driving record and
- I will verify this fact by sending the form ‘Application for Copy of Driving Record’ to the Texas department of Public Safety at the address on the form. I will send \$10.00 in some suitable means to the Department to accomplish the acquisition of my driving record. Upon receiving the record I shall forward it without delay to the Court.

Upon completion of the driver safety course I will submit to the Court the CERTIFICATION OF COMPLETION. I understand that if I fail to submit the certificate to the court within 90 days, I may be required to forfeit the dismissal fee and be required to pay the remaining portion of fines and fees required in the case.
