

DRIVER SAFETY INFORMATION

(I) Driver Safety Course Eligibility:

- 1) Request for DSC must be received by the appearance date indicated on the citation.
- 2) Valid Texas Driver's License
- 3) DSC not taken in past 12 months (for any traffic violation).
- 4) Liability Insurance (effective the date of violation).
- 5) A speeding violation must be **less than 25 mph** over the posted speed limit.
- 6) If you are the holder of a CDL License, you are not eligible for DSC or Deferred Adjudication. (No exceptions).

(II) Driver safety Course Procedures:

- 1) Mail a written plea of Guilty or No-Contest, request form to take the course, proof of insurance, copy of driver's license, self- addressed stamped envelope to receive Driver Record Request form from the Court, and ; \$108.00 to the proper court **before the appearance date on your ticket.**
- 2) Within 90 Days, take the course and mail your certificate of completion to the proper court. The Court must receive the DSC Completion Certificate on or before your due date or you will owe the balance due on your case.

NO EXCEPTIONS

A Defensive Driving Course may be completed by class, video or internet.
